The legal basis for processing is based on your voluntary consent pursuant to Article 6 1 a GDPR in connection with Article 7 GDPR.

By clicking on the respective field in connection with registration for your participation in the development kit competition you consent that your personal data will be collected, processed, and used by us as follows:

- Rutronik Elektronische Bauelemente GmbH and its affiliates (hereinafter referred to as: Rutronik) is authorized to store your company (full legal name), address (company), title (Participant), full name (Participant), Business e-mail-address (Participant), Registration date and to pass on these data to partners mentioned below, to send you information on products and advertising material by email and to contact you by email for the optimization of our services.
- 2. Rutronik is authorized to pass on the information collected according to 1. to Infineon Technologies AG and its affiliates (hereinafter referred to as: Infineon) so they may send you information on their products and advertising material by email and to contact you by email or phone for the optimization of their services.
- 3. To meet legal requirements, the circumstances of your consent (date, time, content) will be recorded.

Your consent is voluntary; not giving it will not result in any disadvantages for you. You can revoke it at any time with effect for the future. If you revoke your consent, your personal data will no longer be used for the aforesaid purposes from the time of such notification and will be deleted – unless we are otherwise authorized to continue storing your personal data. If third parties act as data processors for our company, they are legally obliged to comply with and implement the data protection principles agreed in the relevant data processing agreements.

If data is transferred outside the European Economic Area into a country that may not be subject to equivalent data protection laws we will ensure that a transfer only takes place if an appropriate level of protection is ensured by the recipient and suitable safeguards like Standard Contractual Clauses are provided.



- 4. In connection with the processing of personal data, you have the following rights:
 - a) The right to get information about the personal data processed by Rutronik and Infineon according to Art. 15 GDPR. The information may include the purpose of the data processing, the type of personal data, the recipients or categories of recipient to whom the personal data have been or will be disclosed, the planned period for which the data will be stored, the existence of the right to request rectification or erasure or restriction of processing or to object to such processing, the right to lodge a complaint, the source of the processed data, in cases where these were not collected by Rutronik and Infineon, and the existence of automated decision-making, including profiling, and, if applicable, meaningful information on the particulars involved.
 - b) The right to rectification of inaccurate personal data or the completion of incomplete data stored by Rutronik and Infineon, without delay, according to Art. 16 GDPR.
 - c) The right to erasure of personal data stored by Rutronik and Infineon according to Art. 17 GDPR, unless processing is necessary to exercise the right of freedom of expression and information, for compliance with a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.
 - d) The right to restriction of processing of personal data according to Art. 18 GDPR, insofar as you contest the accuracy of the personal data, or the processing is unlawful, but you oppose their erasure, or Rutronik and Infineon no longer need the data but you need them for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims, or when you have objected to processing according to Article 21 GDPR;
 - e) The right to receive the personal data that you have provided in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or to request transmission of the data to a third party according to Article 20 GDPR;
 - f) The right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority according to Article 77 GDPR. In general, you can make the complaint to the supervisory authority at your habitual place of residence or the location of Rutronik's or Infineon's registered office.
 - g) The right to object according to Article 21 GDPR to processing of personal data where processing is based on Article 6, para. 1, item f) GDPR for the purposes of the legitimate interests pursued by Rutronik and Infineon or a third party, except where such interests are overridden by your interests or fundamental rights and freedoms which require protection of personal data.
